

James Webster and his first wife Margaret Ballant who married 06 Dec 1868 in Frimley, Surrey, England are my 2<sup>nd</sup> great grandparents. Margaret Ballant was previously married to (?) Smith and had a daughter Margaret born abt 1862.

James Webster and Margaret had one child Elizabeth Annie Webster, the only child of James Webster. Elizabeth Annie was born 20 Nov 1868 York Town, Surrey, England and baptized there on the 19 Dec 1869. Yorktown was renamed Camberley in 1877.

Margaret (Ballant) Webster died in June 1874 York Town and was buried 25 Jun 1874 St. Michael's Church Cemetery Camberley.

On the 10 Oct 1892 Elizabeth Annie Webster married Alfred "George" Hockley born 18 Jul 1869 Alton, Hampshire, England (son of James Hockley and Jane Gates). Alton is located 20 miles from Camberley. At the time of their marriage George Hockley was a corporal in the Hampshire Regiment stationed at Gosport. Hampshire.

George fought at some point in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Boer War (11 October 1899 - 31 May 1902)

The family had been stationed at Portsmouth, Alton and Aldershot between 1892 and 1900. By 1901 they are living on Ash Road, Badshot Lea, Rural Farnham, Surrey with their four children Lilly (my grandmother), George, Ethel and Nellie. (Badshot Lea is a small village 2.3 miles NE of Farnham, Surrey, close to Aldershot.

By the time Elizabeth Annie and Alfred George left Surrey they had 7 children the last born in Bagshot Lea in 1905 (along with Muriel who died in 1897) and 3 sons born in Brandon, MB

George left for Canada aboard the Pomeranian arriving 1 June 1906 and Elizabeth and 7 children followed arriving 8 Nov 1906 (Sardinian).

Elizabeth Annie (Webster) Hockley died 4 Feb 1935 in Brandon, Manitoba and Alfred George Hockley died 15 Sep 1937 Brandon.
